Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Do not let people into your rooms and keep a safe distance from other people in your building
- Do not allow visitors into the building without the permission of the landlord or property manager
- Do not congregate in the hallways, front of building, lounges or kitchens
- Keep a safe distance from people at all times

SHARING A KITCHEN

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Set up a rota system for using the kitchen
- Any self-isolated person should wear a mask, use the kitchen last and take their food back to their room
- Where possible use a dishwasher to clean tableware & utensils
- Avoid sharing tableware & utensils
- Where possible keep food in your rooms
- Ensure the owner of items that are chilled are clearly identifiable

DOING LAUNDRY

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Wash items in line with the manufacturer's instructions
- Use the warmest water setting and dry items completely
- Dirty laundry that has been in contact with an unwell person can still be washed with other people's items
- Do not shake dirty laundry as this may disperse the virus
- Clean and disinfect anything used for transporting laundry

SHARING A TOILET

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Thoroughly clean the toilet after every use
- Wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds
- Wash the hand basin after every use
- Do not share towels

GETTING RID OF WASTE

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Waste (including tissues) from anyone living in the house who has shown symptoms recently should be:
 - Put it in a plastic rubbish bag and tied when full
 - Placed in a second bin bag and tied
- This can then be put it with the normal waste after at least 72 hours
- If storage for at least 72 hours is not appropriate, arrange for collection as a **Category B infectious waste**, either by your local council or by a specialist clinical waste contractor. They will give orange clinical waste bags to put your bags into so the waste can be sent for appropriate treatment.
