

Using Your Dehumidifier

Why Use the Dehumidifier?

- Prevents damp and mould by removing excess moisture from the air.
- Helps clothes dry faster without needing to open windows on cold or wet days.
- Reduces heating costs since dry air is easier to warm than damp air.

How to Use It

- Place it in the same room as your drying clothes with at least 30cm clearance around it.
- Hang your clothes on an airer, not directly on radiators.
- Switch it on and use the 'Laundry' or 'Continuous' setting if available, otherwise use the highest fan speed.
- Close doors and windows to help it work efficiently.
- Empty the water tank when full and replace securely.

When to Use It

- On laundry days: Run it while your washing is drying indoors.
- During cold, damp or rainy weather: Helps prevent condensation on windows and walls.

Safety and Tips

- Always follow the instructions in the manufacturer's manual.
- Do not cover or block the air vents.
- Ensure the dehumidifier is on a flat, stable surface.
- Turn it off before moving it to another room.
- Keep cords and water tanks away from small children and pets.

Using the dehumidifier regularly will help protect the property and make your home more comfortable
