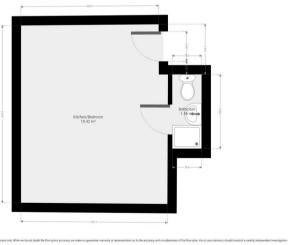

Not to use the Property otherwise than as student accommodation Not to do anything on the Property or the Building or on the rest of the Estate which may cause annoyance, nuisance, damage or inconvenience to the tenants or occupiers of the other Apartments or any adjoining or neighbouring property or to the Landlord which may prejudice the character or value of the Building as residential apartments
- Not to change the external appearance of the Building or the Property (whether that external appearance be to the outside world or the interior of the Building) nor make any structural alteration to the Property or the Building without first obtaining the written consent of the Management Company
- 3. Not to display any poster, advertisement, notice or other writing of any description so as to be visible outside the Property
- 4. Not to erect or allow to be erected any board, sign or notice advertising the Property for sale or to let on the Building or any other part of the Estate except in a form and position approved by the Management Company, such approval not to be unreasonably withheld
- 5. Not to overload or strain any part of the Property or the Building or set up any

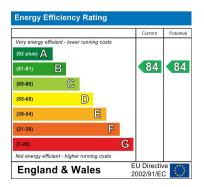

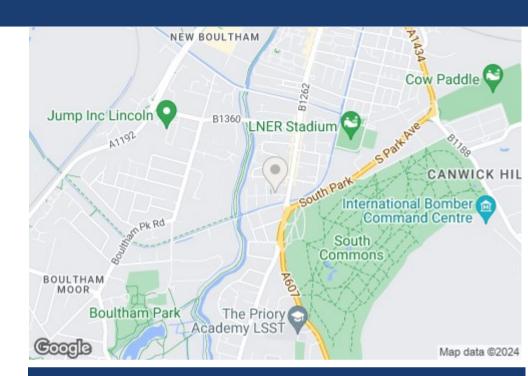
